The Teacher Wins Best Feature Film at the Sun in a Net Awards FEATURED

BRATISLAVA: *The Teacher* directed by Jan Hřebejk won five awards, including best film, at the Sun in a Net awards. But it was outshone by *A Prominent Patient* by Julius Ševčík, which received eight awards, including most of the technical awards.

The official Sun in a Net ceremony was held in the Old Town Hall on 7 April 2017. Ten selected films competed in 15 statutory categories.

The event was a part of the domestic showcase Slovak Film Week, which was organised by the Slovak Film and Television Academy (SFTA) and held in Bratislava from 3 to 9 April 2017.

The Sun in a Net was a bi-annual event until 2016, when it became an annual event due to the increasing number of domestic productions.
